Society of “after school club teachers” (DUPB) each year, on the 1st of April, organizes a conference on a chosen topic. This year they decided to choose topic, where participants of the conference will learn about the Storyline approach. It was a great pleasure for us that Steve Bell and Sallie Harkness responded to our invitation and have together with Lea Nakrst presented Storyline to nearly 90 teachers from 40 different schools all around Slovenia who participated at the first Storyline meeting in Slovenia.



At the workshops participants got a great insight into Storyline work. Groups lived as families in the community, such as employees or visitors of the street with shops and as a staff of the Animal Rescue Centre, which they named as “Zootišče”. Participants got plenty of different ideas to use Storyline in their teaching.





Responses of the participants were remarkable, which proves that also in Slovenian schools Storyline can be used as a flexible teaching strategy that allows many students' creativity and freedom within the framework that teacher has planned to achieve curriculum objectives.
